Non -edibles: socks, gloves, scarves, hats (all for males) shaving foam, toothpaste, toothbrush, shaving gel, deodorant and flannels.

Edibles: chocolate, biscuits, sweets, coffee, sugar, tinned ham, tinned fruit, tinned custard and rice pudding. Please write what is inside on your label.

This is a venture where the generosity of our parents has been well received in the past. We feel that this focus on charity work will provide children with a concrete understanding of the needs of the less fortunate in our society.

We hope that you will be able to support our attempt to engage in the spirit of Christmas. If however, you do not wish to support this venture, please ask your child to return the tag onto the tree.
