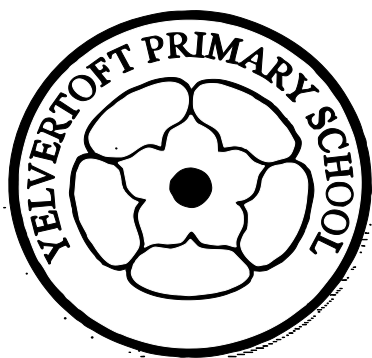

Congratulations to the School Council who raised £90 at their wonderful Boston Tea Party.

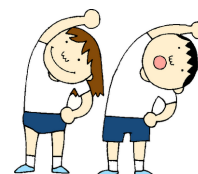
