Dear Parents

We are all very much looking forward to our trip going ahead at the end of June. I am attaching an information pack for parents to this letter and a pupil information sheet, which will need to be returned to school by Friday 18th June.

I can confirm that Mr Dow, Miss Jones, Miss Morris and Mrs Donohoe will be accompanying the children on the residential. Kingswood have provided us with reassurance that they have arrangements in place to minimise contact between groups at the centre. The coach company has also provided us with reassurance that the coach will be sanitised and the driver will be wearing a face mask.

Class 3 and 4 will form one bubble for the residential trip.

The centre has provisionally set up the following activities for the children, which are in line with the current guidance.

- > Beach Adventure
- > Zip Wire
- > Climbing
- > Obstacle challenge
- > Team tech
- > Night Line guiding partner
- > Orienteering
- > Campfire

If the guidance does change prior to the trip the activities may change but the children will not be taking part in any water based activities except paddling on the beach.

We will be holding a zoom meeting for parents on Wednesday 9^{th} June at 4pm during which we will share the powerpoint giving you more information about the specific centre the children will be staying in. If you are unable to attend this zoom, the powerpoint will also be put on the school website and if you have any questions please do email your child's class teacher.



















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The children will be in 4 groups for the activities during the trip and will be in smaller groups for sleeping. We have been allocated a whole floor at the centre for our accommodation so there will be plenty of room. The class teachers will be allocating the children into these groups before they go. They will all have at least one friend in their activity group.
