As part of our fundraising work this Christmas we would like to support the Hope Centre in Rugby.

A special Christmas tree has been placed in the entrance hall, with gift tags on. Each tag has an item labelled on it that is desperately needed by less fortunate and homeless people in the Rugby area. Every child will select a tag next week and if you feel you would like to support this charity, the item can be bought and gift wrapped. Children can put their own message on the tag but use their first name only please. Please remember to write what the gift is on the label. The gift can then be left underneath the tree in the entrance hall to be collected by the Hope Centre on Wednesday 14th December.

If you wish to donate something additional to the item on your child's tag, then we enclose a list of all items needed.

Non-edibles: black thermal snoods, men's manicure sets, thermal socks & vests, thermal cups, rucksacks, gel hand warmers, gloves, scarves, hats shaving foam, toothpaste and toothbrush, toothbrush holder, shaving gel, deodorant and flannels, individual packets of tissues, boxer shorts (S M & L), joggers (S M L) and torches.

Edibles: selection boxes/chocolate, packets of boiled sweets/mints, sachets of coffee, hot chocolate, teabags, sugar, milk pods, hot chocolate, biscuits, coffee, sugar.

This is a venture where the generosity of our parents has been well received in the past. We feel that this focus on charity work will provide children with a concrete understanding of the needs of the less fortunate in our society.

We hope that you will be able to support our attempt to engage in the spirit of Christmas.

If, however, you do not wish to support this venture, please send the tag back into school to be put back on the tree.
